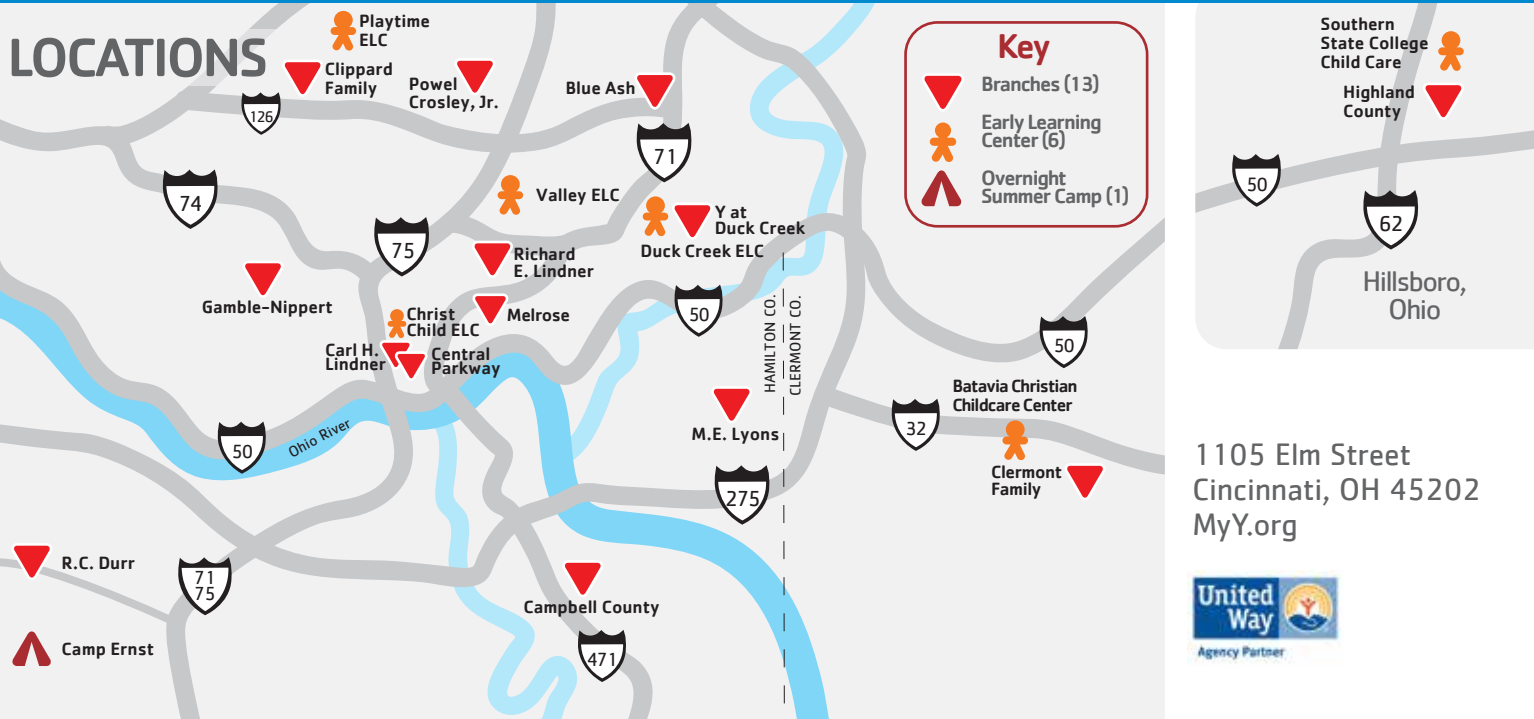
MISSION To put Christian principles into practice through programs that build healthy spirit, mind, and body for all.
